Pastor's Letter

When We Get It RIGHT

DEFYING GRAVITY - WHEN WE GET IT

RIGHT There is a lot to say about how we manage and view the purpose of money. Over the past four weeks, the church's worship theme has been Defying Gravity. Our lead pastor, Rev. Steve Stultz Costello, developed our focus to climax with the October 29th '2024 Pledge Commitment' day. Each year at MUMC, we make a

concerted effort to align our faith commitment with our tithes and offerings. In order to project for the coming year, we are seeking to defy, resist, guard against. We are a strong giving church and it has been cultivated from a posture of blessed people bless people. The great poet, the late Maya Angelou was quoted saying "When we give cheerfully and accept gratefully, everyone is blessed."

"When We Get It Right" such peace abounds. God is interested in the development of our faith. So, when you get 'the giving thing' settled in your life, you don't squirm and shirk at the blatant needs of others. In fact, you feel secure that you have rightfully shared of your blessings. Awww, plop, plop, fizz, fizz, oh what a relief it is, when we get it right!

Our scripture passage for this week zeros in on the way we view treasures, the things we value and how God values us. We see, in **Luke 12:13-21**, that all the things we want to hoard and keep for ourselves can be taken from us in the blink of an eye. The man in Jesus' parable built more and more garages, storage units, barns to encase all of his 'stuff'. And he locked it all up to retreat to a life of leisure. Yet, God questioned him about his will, his plans for the afterlife, saying "who will get all that you have stored up?" As to say, don't withhold and hoard your possessions, but share, and share from the heart.

I worked with a lady who would bring desserts to work. She would withhold/hide the good

stuff, like the lemon meringue or the sweet potato pie, for the people she liked (which I was uneasily one of them). While she would offer others the store-bought cakes and stale, day-old pastries, she stored up her 'treasures' and gave discriminately. Church, God loves when we give cheerfully, God loves the cheerful, willing giver. Our focus, on Defying Financial Gravity, at this time of



committed giving, is how good and satisfied we feel, WHEN WE GET IT RIGHT!

It's an old song but Grammy award singer, Patti LaBelle, belts out a song that says: When You've Been Blessed, It Feels Like Heaven. And when we understand that God provides all things for us and gives indiscriminately, we can give without reserve, without restriction. And when we do, it feels like how heaven is described—a sense of comfort, assurance, peace and security. Ah church, when we get 'the giving thing' right, everyone is blessed!
