

Pastor's Letter

Spring Greetings,

In these weeks following Easter, we are exploring the book of 1 Peter. The writer of this book calls our attention back to the transformative work of God in and through the resurrection. Through Jesus' resurrection, we are given new birth, a new start, a new beginning. In Christ's resurrection, God revealed to us the scope and depth of God's love for us. This love pursues and changes us. The love and the newness that we know in Christ Jesus requires us to examine how we live our lives. 1 Peter tells us that as God's children, we ought to live Christ-like lives. As Easter people, those who trust that the resurrection is true, are called to live our lives in light of the sacrifice of Christ, loving others with our whole heart, and being obedient to God.

Theologian and Bishop in The United Methodist Church Will Willimon writes this, "Easter is about a whole new world, not someday, but today. Not somewhere in eternity, but now. Of course, that whole new world is not completely here, not in its fullness. But it is sure on the way...It is the vision of Easter, the vision that is the most powerful motivation for Christian action in this world. We know a secret about the world and the direction in which the world is moving—Jesus Christ is risen!" Jesus Christ has risen and it proves God's love toward us. Our lives serve as our response to God's love and power. This is our living hope that loosens all the bonds that once tied us.

Jesus Christ is risen!




Change the World Day


