

#### I AM / WE ARE: I AM THE TRUE VINE



John 15:1-2, 4-8 ESV 1 "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. 2 Every branch in me that does not bear fruit he takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. 4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. 5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. 6 If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. 7 If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.

This "I AM" statement is one that I am not familiar with at all. This term "true vine" is not like the other six I AM phrases for me. The writer, John, exclaims the power of Christ in pinpointing Jesus as he says I Am:

- the Light of the World, the Bread of Life,
- the Gate/The Good Shepherd, •the True Vine,
  - ${\ensuremath{\bullet}}$  the Resurrection and the Life,  ${\ensuremath{\bullet}}$  the Door,
    - the Way, the Truth and the Life.

So, I had to really study and search for enlightenment on this "true vine" concept.



My first thought was to turn to music, and my mind

went straight to the great Marvin Gaye singing a 1960s tune hit of "I Heard it Through the Grape Vine, which has nothing to do with this I Am statement, but the word 'vine' pressed on me.

I'm finding so many analogies and illustrations from Jesus of being the Vine and us being the branches, along with the fruit we are to bear. I mean, WOW! The thoughts of plants growing, being planted, being cut back, being pruned, being alive, being dead, growing tall, growing outward...the ideas won't stop!

Jesus provides for us a beautiful vision where we are all connected to the same vine. We, as branches, leaves, shoots of his powerful stem of life. This image shows us that we have our life and our being only alongside Christ, the True Vine.

I'm not a super gardener, but I have always loved getting into the dirt and making pretty flowers array my home. Some others are vegetable growers and farmers even. And yet, this concept of us being connected to Christ and given the ability to grow and flourish should be a source of contentment for us. As we are connected to God, through the True Vine, we have a great chance to become examples of his love and grace. *Pastor lvy*
