PASTOR'S LETTER

I am the way, the truth and the life – John 14:6a

Ever since last Sunday, I have been thinking about Jesus as the vine and all of us as the branches and what it means to abide! I'm picturing God in the form of Pastor Ivy's 98-year-old grandmother bent over pulling weeds so that vegetables can grow and bear fruit. Thank you, Pastor Ivy, for your message!

I've also been meditating on Jesus as the way, the truth and the life especially as the way. How are you with directions and finding your way? I do pretty well as long as my cell phone has a good connection, and my GPS app is working! A couple of weeks ago someone asked me what roads I take to get to the church from my home in Shaker Heights. I said, "I just go where the GPS tells me to go!" Since then, I'm starting to take note of the names of the streets. Somebody ask me the same question this Sunday, I should be able to tell you!

Knowing which way to go is comforting and empowering. Even if the journey is long, if you know the way, you can embrace it and get on the road. But, what is the way that Jesus is talking about? What does he mean that he is the way? What is the Jesus way? What we do know is that when Jesus says "I am the way...," he is on his way to the cross. I confess that if I think of Jesus as my GPS, and the way points to a cross on a dark hillside, I'm likely to pull over and reboot in hopes of finding another way. How about you? Let's wrestle with this together.
