


PASTOR'S LETTER

I AM / WE ARE: The Bread of Life



God has a sincere desire for us to know Him. And so, Jesus takes seven opportunities to impress upon the crowd of that day and to us, that Jesus is all that we need.

The phrase, "I am the bread of life," is one of several "I Am" statements that Jesus spoke in the Gospel of John. I am the Bread of Life is a title Jesus used to describe himself in John 6:35:

"I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry again. Whoever believes in me will never be thirsty".

I believe that **we are** in a time, like the people of that day, when people are needing a sign of the validity of God.

Like the people in that day, there are many who are more interested in a performance than the person. They were interested, and naturally so, in Jesus' ability to heal, to cure, and for this moment in John 6, to feed the masses. They were interested and followed Jesus because he was giving out free food, in fact, all you can eat! When Jesus feed the crowd of 5,000 men, same number of women and double the number of children everyone walked away with full bellies. So, they loved the performances, acts, miracles of Jesus, but the part about knowing, trusting and believing in Jesus, was slow and met with resistance.

I am like the people in this passage. We are like the people in this passage. I am and we are often lacking the will, the nerve to rely on God in every situation. When Jesus says "I am the Bread of Life" he assures us that all we need, beyond the physical, temporary needs of life, Jesus provides. May we ever renew our commitment to our faith, believing and trusting that we can be filled and fulfilled with the Bread of Life which is Christ Jesus.
