Hymn History: The music to this hymn was written by Frederick Challinor. Born in Langton, England in 1866, Challinor was the son of a miner who was also a Methodist Lay Preacher. He began working in a brickworks at age ten and as a miner by age twelve. His family received a cottage piano as a legacy and this inspired Challinor to study music. Though sometimes ridiculed by his co-workers, he continued studying music on his own. A cottage piano is an upright piano about four feet tall. Frederick left the mines and attended the Royal College of Music where he graduated with distinction in 1897. He wrote the music to this hymn for a competition sponsored by the National Sunday School Union of London. He used the words to a hymn written earlier by William H Parker. Challinor died in Paignton, England in 1952.




