Hymn History: The music to this hymn was written by William H. Doane. He was born in 1832 in Connecticut. Musically gifted, he was playing the flute, violin, and double bass as a teenager. Dr. Doane was a successful business man, music composer and philanthropist. He composed over 2,000 hymns. He was the choir director of the Mt. Auburn Baptist Church in Cincinnati. He donated generously to many Baptist institutions, particularly Denison University in Granville, Ohio who awarded him an honorary doctorate of music. The Doane Administration Building and Doane Library are named in his honor. He died in 1915 in New Jersey.

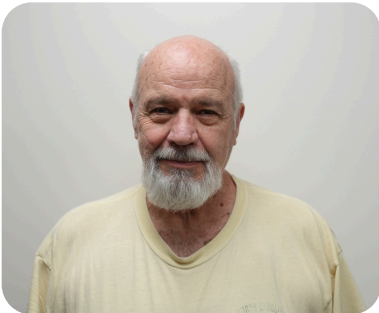
