Hymn History: The words to this hymn were written by Reginald Heber. He was born in England in 1783, the son of an Anglican priest. Heber himself became a priest after graduating from Oxford University. He was a poet and hymn writer in addition to his clerical duties. He served churches in England for seventeen years before being appointed as Bishop of Calcutta, India, in 1823. He died in India in 1826. The words to this hymn were published posthumously and put to music by John Dykes, 1823-1876. Dykes was an accomplished composer and Anglican priest educated at Cambridge University and ordained at York Minster Cathedral. Dykes named his music Nicaea in honor of the Council of Nicaea in 325 A.D., which formalized the doctrine of the Trinity. The council also gave us the Nicene Creed, which is still recited today, as well as creating the formula for setting the date for Easter Sunday.


