*Hymn History*: The music to this hymn is based on the song CWN Rhondda (Rhondda Valley) by John Hughes. He was born in Dowlais, Wales in 1873. Hughes had his first job at the age of twelve as door boy at a coal mine. He later worked as a clerk at the Great Western Colliery in Pontypridd, Wales for forty years. Hughes was a Deacon and leader of congregational singing at the Salem Baptist Chapel in Llanilltud Faerdref, Wales succeeding his father in both positions. Hughes wrote the music to CWN Rhondda one Sunday afternoon at the organ of the Salem church. The music was premiered at the dedication of the organ at Capel Rhondda in Hopkinson, Wales. Hughes always held secular jobs and wrote music as hobby on the side. This melody is also used in hymns 127 and 577 in our hymnal. He died in Llanilltud Faerdref in 1932.
