*OPENING HYMN

“To God Be the Glory”UMH 98

Hymn History: The words to this hymn were written by Fanny Crosby, one of the most prolific hymn writers in history. Born outside New York City in 1820, she wrote over 8,000 hymn and gospel songs. Crosby went blind at six weeks of age and attended the New York Institute for the Blind. A tireless worker on behalf of the sightless, she testified before a joint session of Congress in 1846, arguing for more blind schools. She worked at several missions and spoke at many churches about the plight of the poor. This hymn did not achieve wide usage until it was used by Cliff Barrows, song leader for Billy Graham in 1954 at a London Crusade. Crosby died in Bridgeport, Connecticut in 1915.

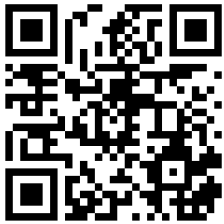
