***HYMN OF MISSION**

Hymn History: The words and music to this hymn were written by Cleland McAfee. Born in Ashley, Missouri in 1866, McAfee graduated from Park College (now Park University) in Parkview, Missouri. The school was founded by his father, John McAfee in 1875. Cleland became a Presbyterian Minister after attending Union Theological Seminary in New York City. McAfee wrote this hymn following the tragic deaths of his two infant nieces from diphtheria. The day of the funeral, McAfee, with broken voice, sang this hymn outside his brother's home, which was quarantined due to the illness. Among the books he wrote was a study of the King James Bible. McAfee died in 1944 in Asheville, North Carolina.


