*CALL TO WORSHIP

Hymn History: This hymn has words written by George William Kitchen and later modified by Michael Robert Newbolt based on the hymn Crucifer written by Sir Sydney Hugo Nicholson. Sir Sydney was born in London, England in 1875. He graduated from the Royal College of Music where he studied the organ. He served as organist at Carlisle Cathedral, Eton College, Manchester Cathedral and Westminster Abbey. He also founded the Royal School of Church Music in London in 1927. He was knighted for his service to church music in 1938. A crucifer is a person who carries the processional cross for elaborate services on festive days, like our Easter services. The term comes from the latin crux (cross) and ferre (to bear or carry). Nicholson died in Ashford, Kent, England in 1947 and is buried in Westminster Abbey.
