***OPENING HYMN** "When Jesus Came to Jordan" #UMH 252 Hymn History: The words to this hymn were written by Fred Pratt Green. He was born in Roby, Láncashire, England in 1903. Rev. Green was a British Methodist minister serving various churchés and circuits in England from 1928 to 1969. He also wrote the words to over 100 hymns in his lifetime. Many of these are in the United Methodist Hymnal (see the Index Of Composers for the hymns included in our hymnal). Rev. Green was awarded an Honorary Doctor of Humane Letters in 1982 by Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia. Some of his hymn writing materials are housed there. Other materials are at Durham University in England. He set up the Pratt Green Trust which uses the royalties from his works for the advancement of church music. Rev. Green died in Norwich, England in 2000.


