Hymn History: The music to this hymn was written by Phoebe Knapp. She was born in New York City in 1839. Her parents were religious teachers and were estimated to have converted forty thousand souls in their lifetimes. Phoebe married Jospeh Knapp who was the president of Metropolitan Life Insurance Company. They had three children. Jospeh had a pipe organ installed in their New York City apartment, considered to be the largest pipe organ in the world in a private residence. The Knapps were members of the John Street Methodist Episcopal Church (now known as John Street United Methodist Church) located in Lower Manhattan near Ground Zero. It is considered the first Methodist church in America. In 1873, Phoebe composed the music of this hymn to the text written by fellow John Street church member, Fannie Crosby (1820–1915). Phoebe Knapp died in Poland, Maine in 1908.


