"He Leadeth Me"

Hymn History: The words to this hymn were written by Joseph Gilmore. Born in Boston in 1834, he studied at Brown University and Newton Theological Seminary. Gilmore was lecturing at First Baptist Church in Philadelphia in 1862 and preaching on the 23rd Psalm. It was the darkest days of the Civil War and Gilmore was distressed over the upheaval in the land. He pondered God's leadership and decided to discuss the entire Psalm with the congregation. However, he could not get past the second verse and lectured on letting God lead your life, regardless of your experiences. That evening he wrote down his words in a poem and gave them to his wife. She sent the words, without his knowledge, to a newspaper in Boston. William Bradbury, the famous hymn writer put the words to music. Three years later, Joseph Gilmore became a Baptist minister in Rochester, New York. He opened up the hymnal and there was his poem as a hymn. Gilmore also taught English at the University of Rochester. He died in Rochester in 1918.
