Hymn History: The music to this hymn is base on a Welsh Folk song, Ash Grove (Llwyn Onn in the Welsh language). This tune has been arranged and words written for it by many composers over the years, including Ludvig Van Beethoven. It has been used in miniseries on British television and the tune was sung by a group of Welsh coal miners in the movie How Green Was My Valley. The words we sing today were written by Omer Westendorf (1916–1997). He was born in Cincinnati, Ohio and served as choirmaster of St. Bonaventure Catholic Church in Cincinnati for forty years. He composed in English and his hymns were some of the first used by the Roman Catholic Church after Vatican II permitted the Mass to be celebrated in the local language. Westendorf established the World Library of Sacred Music in Cincinnati in 1950, importing liturgical music from Europe to the U.S.
