Our vehicle has a "low driver attention" warning feature. If you drive for too long a period...if you are going too slow (yeah, I probably don't need to worry about that reason emerging)...if you are swerving (the wind caused this to happen last week)...a red warning appears on the dashboard. Pay Attention! Take Notice! Be Aware! "Low Driver Attention"

The Season of Lent begins with an invitation to do some self-reflection.

Lent is an established Church custom with ancient origins...seeking to prepare the faithful to fully receive the mercy and grace of Jesus. This season of 40 days (not including Sundays which are always considered "little Easters") is a time when persons journey with Jesus toward Jerusalem. Through fasting and prayer, giving and service—sacrifice and devotion—one comes to discover God in a deeper way. As the faithful confess and are humble and seek the Lord, the fullness of God is discovered.

Our sermon series, Painting with Ashes, is a journey to discover how our brokenness and weakness can become powerful moments for God to break through. If we allow God...even invite God...to do the work in us.

We begin the journey by traveling with Jesus into the wilderness (Luke 4: 1 – 13).

May you pay attention to yourself this Lenten Season, and through honest self-reflection come to know the depth of God's mercy and love for you!
