



As United Methodists, we are part of a global, connectional Church. This means that what we do at Mentor UMC impacts people around the world, and what happens around the world impacts MUMC. This year, Change the World Day is helping kids in surrounding counties not sleep on the floor. All of Methodism celebrates what Mentor UMC is doing for Christ.

A Connectional Church also means pastoral leadership is always in place. The church does not hire pastors but receives pastors within the connection. Some may think of the UMC as a network, supporting and providing for the needs of all. The local church has input. Through Charge Conference goal setting and in consultation with the district superintendent, the direction for mission and vision of the church is prioritized. Soon Mentor UMC will understand its connection with Fields UMC and Vermillion Grace UMC as Pastor Sondra and Pastor Mikayla move on.

Soon Mentor UMC will learn about North Canton Faith UMC and Canfield UMC as Pastor Steve and Pastor Ivy step into leadership at Mentor UMC. Pastor Steve and Pastor Ivy are ordained Elders and being appointed by Bishop Malone to serve Mentor UMC. Elders are ordained to "Word, Sacrament, Order and Service" and appointed to guide the life of the church. As pastoral transition occurs, many people will engage in the work to assure the mission and vision of Mentor UMC continues. Pastor Sondra and Pastor Mikayla oversee this process.

For many years, Tammy Palermo has served Mentor UMC as the Director of Children and Family Ministries. Sensing a call to ministry, Tammy has furthered her education and will soon complete her master's degree. As part of her journey, Tammy has done the discernment work and been affirmed by the East Ohio Conference Board of Ministry for commissioning as a Deacon. In the UMC, a Deacon is a pastor in the ministry of "Word, Service, Compassion, and Justice, to both the community and the congregation in a ministry that connects the two." Tammy's role working with Mentor UMC's children and family continues but expands to concentrate on MUMC's presence in the community. The current pastoral leadership and SPRC have worked to identify Tammy's changing role, and this work will continue. Tammy will be commissioned at the Annual Conference in June. Effective July 1, Bishop Malone has appointed Tammy to serve at Mentor UMC in her pastoral role as a deacon, with the title Pastor of Children and Family Ministries.

Pastor Barb Holzhauser serves as the Director of Congregational Care at Mentor UMC. Pastor Barb is a retired Lutheran pastor hired by Mentor UMC to serve in this important role. Within our UMC system, she is not appointed but hired. This does not minimize her role, her credentials, or experience. It is simply a distinction within the UMC system.

As we seek to understand our United Methodist way of doing things, and navigate through a season of transition, please reach out to Pastor Sondra or Pastor Mikayla if you have questions or comments. 


