"Spirit of the Living God" **HYMN OF CENTERING** Hymn History: This hymn was written by Daniel Iverson. Born in Georgia in 1890, he graduated

from the University of Georgia and the Columbia Theological Seminary. Rev. Iverson was ordained a Presbyterian Minister. He served at churches in North and South Carolina, Georgia, and Florida. While at the church in Tarboro, North Carolina in 1926, he wrote the words to this hymn. A plague at the church commemorates the occasion. Rev. Iverson was inspired by the words in Jeremiah 18: 1-6 where the Lord instructs Jeremiah to visit a potter. The Lord says to Jeremiah that just as a potter can remold a pot, He can remold Israel. Rev. lverson died in North Carolina in 1977.
