...TO ONE HE GAVE FIVE TALENTS, TO ANOTHER TWO, TO ANOTHER ONE - MATTHEW 25:15

Are you ready for this? Ok, here we go. What would you do if your boss stopped by your office and handed you \$3,948,000 (Three million, nine hundred and forty-eight Dollars!) and said, "Here, take care of this. I'm going away for a while."? Would your answer be any different if the amount was \$1,579,200? How about \$789,600? What if you knew that your boss stole from others, that your boss "reaped where he or she did not sow"? Would it matter if your boss was a harsh man?

This Sunday, Pastor Ivy and I will be preaching on the second parable in Matthew 25—often called "The Parable of the Talents". The parable begins with a man who before going on a journey calls in three of his slaves and gives them each a large sum of money: five talents to the first slave, two talents to the second slave, and one talent to the third slave. A talent was a unit of money in the first century equal to 6,000 denarii. One denarius equaled an average day's pay for a laborer. The average base pay for a laborer in Ohio, from Indeed.com, is \$16.45/hour. Assuming an 8-hour workday, that's \$131.60/day. Therefore, in today's currency, in Ohio, one denarius equals about \$131.60. One Talent equals 6,000 denarii, so one talent equals \$789,600. Two talents equal \$1,579,200 and five talents equal \$3,948,000.

Here's something to think about, what kind of master leaves that kind of money with his slaves while she or he is away? I'm thinking this is either an extremely trusting master, and/or a very generous master, or a very foolish master. Or, maybe he's just the kind of master who needs to get out of town quickly and he has no other option but to leave his great wealth in the hands of these three slaves.

Unfortunately, the parable doesn't answer these questions for us. Jesus just puts this parable out there for people to chew on and talk over and pray about – and people have...for centuries! What is the message Jesus wants us to get from this parable? How will this parable inspire us to help Jesus make the world look a little more like God's kingdom (or kin-dom)? It's something worth praying about.

Lord, inspire us with this parable about your kingdom. Motivate us to use the gifts you provide in ways that multiply your love and grace in a world that is hurting. Amen? Amen.


