## Pastor's Letter

When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit" – John 20:22

This Sunday is All Saints Sunday and it begins a new 4-week series called "Inspired". We will be using the scriptures provided in the Lectionary—a source used by many churches and pastors from various denominations that leads the church through about 80% of the Bible over a three-year period.

When we think of "saints" we might think of marble statues of incredible historical figures throughout the history of Christianity. Figures like St. Peter, St. Paul, St. Mary and Mother Theresa. While most protestant churches—United Methodist Churches included—affirm these prominent persons as saints, they/we also affirm the radical claim that all of God's people are saints! How can that be? Grace.

By God's grace, revealed to us most profoundly by Jesus' death and resurrection, every person bears a unique resemblance to Christ. Astonishingly, this is true even alongside all the ways each of us misrepresents Christ every day through our actions and inactions that are inconsistent with who we are as children created in God's image.

The invitation of All Saints and this series is to trust this promise from God that each of us and indeed all people are claimed by God, children of God, made in God's image, called good by God, loved by God, forgiven and redeemed by God through Christ and at the same time not yet fully who God has created us/them to be. Imagine going through each day looking for Christ to be revealed in a unique way in each person you meet! When we see Christ in others, when we recognize Christ in others, we are blessed and inspired.

To help us get a better sense of how incredible this prospect is, consider the meaning of "inspired". It comes from the Latin inspirare which means "to breathe or blow into". To be inspired then, is to receive anew God's own breath, God's Spirit being breathed into you. When this happens, as it did to the disciples in John 20:22 and again in Acts 2, and over and over again too many times to be recorded, the world tilts toward God's kingdom—or as we like to say at Mentor UMC—God's kin-dom.

May we each be inspired today and every day by the risen Christ who is present in each of us and beckons to be seen!
