


DEFYING GRAVITY: BREAKING FREE

Author and United Methodist Bishop, Rev. Tom Berlin, explains that just as gravity has a force of hold, pull and restraint on objects and masses, financial gravity exists in the economy that we live in every day. The financial gravity in our society is an orchestrated and calculated to make it easy for us spend, spend and spend. We live in a culture of attaining more and more often without regard to prioritization. It takes a power of

"Breaking Free" to get us to a more sound and respectful balance with money.

In Luke 15:11-32, Jesus tells the story of a young man who totally lacks sound money control. His story, one of the most familiar stories in scripture, is so captivating. (You should read or re-read it) We can see the young man's logic and we understand, although so thoughtless, his desire to exercise such financial freedom.



tendencies to ignore God's provision over our lives. The Prodigal Son story shows us not just a spoiled bratty son, but the story reveals a father to emulate. The young son and the older brother, both, are total ingrates! They are controlled by money and their lives are pitiful description because of it. In the church, talking about finances and monies is often taboo. But know that Jesus tells this story to help us prioritize God's care over the fluidity of money. The generosity that the father shows to both sons, regardless of their selfish bratness, yes bratness, is the real point of the story. Like the father, God's generosity encompasses our trivial demands, our insatiable desires, and our plain ole foolish exploits. Regardless of our age! We must remember to take steps to Defy Gravity, and work toward a consistent, ever-evaluating plan that shows how important God is in our lives. The words of Civilla Martin's hymn, written in 1904, is one of the most reassuring songs in our hymnal. It rings out the comforting message, "God Will Take Care of You", that Defies Financial Gravity and set us on or keeps us on a path of generosity.
