




Pastor's Letter

DEFYING GRAVITY - DISCOVERING GRAVITY



The word of God in Ecclesiastes 5:7-20 and Matthew 19:16-26 set a framework around the message of our new worship series theme. The revelations found in the book "Defying Gravity" by United Methodist clergy, Rev. Tom Berlin, will guide us for four weeks on principles of stewardship and giving. He presents "gravity" as an emotional, psychological



and sociological force that compels us in ways to spend our money.

The gravity-type pull on our use of money should align with our giving to the ministry of Jesus Christ.

My first thought when church/God/money are intertwined always defaults to a gospel song I heard often growing up titled: "You Can't Beat God Giving".

You can't beat God giving, no matter how you try.

For just as sure as you are living and the Lord is in heaven on high.

The more you give, the more He gives to you,


but keep on giving because it's really true

that you can't beat God giving, no matter how you try.

The song harmoniously reminds us of how much God gives us and how we should in immulation, respond. It may be a cliché, yet it rings true that you can give without loving, but you cannot love without giving. God wants our giving to be solely in response to His giving. So, why give? We give because we love God. We give because giving glorifies God. We give because we trust God. We give because we are blessed, privileged and favored!

The word of God reminds us in:

- **John 3:16** ¹⁶ For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- **Psalm 84:11** If For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.
- James 1:17 ¹⁷ Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.



We cannot give to God without planning, without budgeting or without prioritization. And God blesses us as we have our finances in an hierarchical place that does not supersede God.

Together, in these four weeks as we approach our own stewardship campaign for 2024, we will confront, challenge, rebel against, oppose,

defy the gravitational struggle on our giving to the Lord. Prayerfully, we will be stronger and even more secure in our commitment to giving. $-Pastor\ Ivy$
