Hymn History: The music to this hymn is familiar to many as Beethoven's "Ode to Joy". The words were written by Henry Van Dyke. Van Dyke was born in 1852 in Germantown, PA. He was educated at Princeton and was ordained as a Presbyterian minister. He also taught English Literature at Princeton and was a lecturer at the University of Paris. He officiated at the funeral of Mark Twain in 1910. He served as Ambassador to The Netherlands and Luxembourg in 1913. He looked after the rights of Americans living in Europe in World War I. He wrote a dozen books and over 100 poems. The second section of his poem, *Time Is*, was read at the funeral of Diana, Princess of Wales in 1997. Van Dyke died in Princeton, New Jersey in 1933.
