This week's question in our series, "I've Been Meaning to Ask..." is "What do you need?" We are invited to ponder the wisdom from Job 2 and Paul's reflections from 2 Timothy 4. Inspired by the Job passage, Rev. Garrity's writes about her painting, "Break Open":

In this image, I wanted to evoke the emotional impact of rending one's clothing in solidarity with someone who is hurting. While this ancient cultural practice might feel curious to us now, I love that it's an embodied way to tear away the armor that guards our own hearts so we can truly show up—tenderly—to join another in their pain.

I admire people who have the ability to be a non-anxious presence with those who are in pain. I think it is both a gift and a skill. Job's friends are able to provide this kind of empathetic presence with Job for three days. Incredible! However, chapters 4-37, those same friends are relentless with their advice and judgements, certain they know the root of Job's plight. It's so hard to just be present!

Rev. Pittman's art "Paul in Prison" inspired by 2 Timothy is also worth pondering. The artist writes:

In this block print, I carved Paul writing this letter to Timothy. The lines on his skin echo the twists and turns of his life while the lines on the page give him release. The cell bars obscure the view, however, the light of his halo and the power of his letter cannot be contained. His hand reaches just beyond one of the bars because in receiving forgiveness, reaching out for companionship, and letting go of guilt and resentment, he is free.

As followers of Jesus, we are called to care for one another and when we are in need, to allow others to care for us. How is God calling you to be with someone in need? How are you at communicating to others what you need?

Letter from Missions

Because of the continued generosity of our congregation, the Missions Committee has been able to direct funds that will make a difference in the lives of many, both locally and far away.

Project Hope for the Homeless of Painesville is building a "Welcome Home Center" which will be used to provide (free of charge) small appliances, start-up household goods and supplies for the new homes of their residents that transition to their own homes. 86% of Project Hope residents leave the program ready to find and live in their own residence or to obtain treatment.

Mentor UMC is giving \$5,000 towards their \$100,000 goal to build the Welcome Home Center.

In August, this congregation gave generously to the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) to help meet the disaster relief efforts in Maui. Mentor UMC generously supports UMCOR efforts annually both for disaster relief in the United States and around the world.

While the needs are great for all people and organizations in Maui, the Missions Committee also chose to give an additional \$5000 directly to our sister congregation, The Lahaina United Methodist Church, to help them rebuild their church facility. Their church building was leveled to the ground by the fires that struck the island in early August.

Our members always respond generously in the service of God's children wherever the needs may be. If your heart is so moved concerning these two important needs, you are always welcome to add to these funds by writing a check made out to Mentor UMC with "Welcome Home Center" or "Lahaina UMC" written on the note line or through our church website.
