Pastor's Letter

Hello Friends,

Yesterday marked an incredibly huge moment for me. One that in all reality was shown to me in 2007 but pushed down until 2021 when I finally answered God's call to ordained ministry. After finally saying "YES!" to God, it has been a whirlwind the past four years. Here is a brief recap:

- August 24, 2021, began seminary at Methodist Theological School in Ohio
- March 24, 2022, became a Certified Candidate in the East Ohio Annual Conference
- May 15, 2023, graduated MTSO with a Master of Arts of Practical Theology
- June 9, 2023, commissioned as a Provisional Deacon in the East Ohio Annual Conference
- May 17, 2025, graduated MTSO with a Master of Divinity
- June 15, 2025, ordained as a Deacon in full connection in the East Ohio Annual Conference

Some may be wondering about this timeline and the two degrees from MTSO. I want to offer some clarification. In order to apply for provisional status in the UMC, you have to complete half of your coursework for your degree. I decided I wanted to continue to earn my MDiv. knowing that my MAPT would be absorbed into that degree. This happened after completing my interviews for change of status from certified candidate to provisional deacon. It is safe to say that I now completely understand why the process is set up the way that it is.

Part of the provisional process includes participating in a two-year program, *Crucible*, with others who are provisional from both East and West Ohio Annual Conferences. It was an incredible experience not only from the educational aspect but also from the bonding with other clergy. In order to move forward towards ordination, one must create and implement a Bible study and an ordination project. There are still papers to write and submit, not to mention preparing two sermons and the order of worship for each. And then the interviews!

I decided to continue my seminary education while doing all of the necessary requirements for ordination. If you asked why I did it this way, I would respond that I wanted to become ordained as soon as I could because I know the retirement age in the UMC is 72 years old. I felt as if I had already missed out on serving God as a Deacon and didn't want to wait longer.

I want to thank YOU all for your support and encouragement while I pursued this call. The Mentor UMC staff went above and beyond when staff meetings had to be scheduled around my class schedule. I know that many had to make major adjustments for me, and I am forever grateful. Thank you to all who attended the Charge Conference on March 22, 2022, to approve and affirm me to become a certified candidate. And the prayers! I know that I would not have been able to do all of this in four years without YOUR prayers. I cannot thank you enough for all you have done! I also want to thank my husband, Michael, who has been cheering me on throughout this journey. Thank you to Eliana and Evan for believing in me even though neither took up my challenge to see who could have the best grades each semester.



I look forward to seeing how God will continue to guide me as I serve Mentor UMC and the community. If you hear God calling you to ministry, please let me know, so I can come alongside you.

Pastor Steve Renewal Leave

First published & verbally announcement in worship on 4-27-25

We hope this message finds you well and thriving in your faith journey. We are pleased to announce that Pastor Steve will be taking renewal leave from July 1 to August 26, 2025.

The Staff Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) unanimously approved Pastor Steve's request at their March 25 meeting, and he has also received support from our District Superintendent, Rev. Angela Lewis. As outlined in the United Methodist Book of Discipline, renewal leave may include study, travel, spiritual retreat, or other restorative activities that enhance ministry effectiveness. This opportunity for rest, recharge, and spiritual refocus is encouraged for all clergy in the United Methodist Church every six years. Pastor Steve's last renewal leave was in 2017, making this a timely and muchdeserved break.

Pastor Steve plans to travel to Virginia to visit family and explore the Appalachian Trail, and to Canada, where he and his wife Cara share a cabin with her siblings. He will also spend time reading, studying, working on home projects, and enjoying special outings with his sons, Eli and Atticus.

During Pastor Steve's leave, Pastor Ivy will serve as Senior Pastor, with Pastor Tammy assisting in pastoral responsibilities. Preaching and worship will be led by Pastor Ivy and Pastor Tammy, along with guest preachers for two or three Sundays. Rev. Barb Holzhauser will provide pastoral care assistance as needed.

Pastor Steve has expressed that he is not feeling burned out and feels blessed to serve as the Sr. Pastor at Mentor United Methodist Church. He remains energized and excited about our future together, attributing part of his vitality to proactive renewal leave.


