FAITH SHARING




Come and hear, all you who fear God, and I will tell what he has done for my soul.—Psalm 66:16 ESV

clear and present reality, that experience is a **faith sharing**. The Apostle Paul reiterates in Philippians 1:12 that everything that happened to him has helped him to spread the Good News, to **share** his **faith**!




More Than a Meal
