Hymn History: The words and music of this hymn were written by Dan Schotte. He was born in 1947 in Neenah, Wisconsin. Schotte graduated from Marquette University and entered the Society of Jesus (Jesuits). He wrote contemporary songs set to sacred texts sung in English following the modernizing of the Roman Catholic Mass at the Second Vatican Council. Schotte left the Society of Jesus in 1986 and continues to write liturgical songs, many of which are now used by Christians of all denominations. His most popular is the hymn we sing today. The inspiration of the lyrics is from the I Samuel 3 where the Lord calls for Samuel. He answers "Here I am Lord". Schotte is currently the Composer-in Residence at the University of San Francisco.
