Pastor's Letter

Then God said, "Let us make humankind in our image, according to our likeness..." - Genesis 1:26

For we are what he has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works... - Ephesians 2:10

So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation... - 2 Corinthians 5:17

I have always loved hearing and reading good stories. Some of the best stories I have found are in children's books. Over the years, my wife Cara and I have accumulated a nice collection of children's books. The best ones tell a story that illustrate the same truth and wisdom we find in the Bible and in our faith. Telling fiction stories that reveal divine truth is itself a biblical tradition! The Israelites were masterful storytellers and so was Jesus! Much of the gospels are filled with Jesus telling stories and parables to teach people (children and adults) about the Kingdom of God.

This week we begin a new three-week sermon and worship series inspired by three of my favorite children's books. The scripture passages above are the focus passages for each week in the series. You can see that each one tells us a profound truth about our identity and sense of self. We are all made by God and created in Christ! And, when we get beat up by the storms of life, forget who we are, even cause harm to others and/or ourselves, Christ is there with arms open ready to restore us into a new creation. This message is central to our faith, and central to Jesus' Good News throughout the Gospels. Yet, it is a message that we need to hear over and over again, told in new and creative ways, sung in songs, prayed in prayers, danced in the streets, painted on walls, proclaimed in sermons, tasted in broken bread...and shared in children's stories.

I invite you to treat yourself to a fresh hearing of the Good News heard in these three children's books and seen in their beautiful illustrations. They are some of my favorites!

August 18 - Old Turtle by Douglas Wood, watercolors by Cheng-Khee Chee August 25 - You Are Special by Max Lucado, illustrated by Sergio Martinez September 1 - Fly, Eagle, Fly! retold by Christopher Gregorowski, pictures by Niki Daly

I will be preaching in the Modern services for this series. Pastor Ivy will be preaching in Traditional on August 18th and September 1st. Pastor Tammy will be preaching in Traditional on August 25th.

Each Sunday we will read the book in the church library at 10:10 AM and again at 12:10 PM. I hope you will plan on sticking around for another 15–20 minutes to hear these stories together.


