

WRESTLING..DEBATING. STRUGGLING.GRAPPLE. QUESTIONING...TRYING.

Nothing messes up your thought process like College Philosophy 100! Oh boy! Nothing stretches your moral, integral, or foundational boundaries like being 18, 19 years old, away from parents, and having to express or better yet, having others express themselves!

Well, we are challenged every day by life and

living. And those challenges can bring either security and trust or skepticism and doubt. Either way, life keeps on moving. We all become unsettled at times about the answers to life's most important questions:

Ones God exist? •Is there a God? •What is God like? •Why are we here?
 •What happens when we leave here? •Is the Bible reliable?
 •Is there a heaven?

•Why do people suffer? •What about unanswered prayers? •Is there a hell? Doubt and plausibility began with Adam and Eve and we are not exempt.

Every person will eventually ask these types of questions, yet how we answer them will affect how we live and how we view the world.

Many people say that this series: "Wrestling with Doubt-Finding Faith" has been helpful. Often, after worship service, members share how witnessing to their children, or arguing with in-laws, or deciding for ourselves is a continual struggle throughout life. The answers to the major questions in life become foggier or clearer as we age. Yet, when we feel struggle and doubt, we should fight against distancing from God. God never leaves us nor forsakes us, and when we trust in that knowledge, we can rest in our spirit. Often we pretend we have it all together. We pretend that we have all the answers.

Yet, dear friends, I can give you arguments, debates, statements, and facts, but **nothing will convince you until you respond in faith.** When you respond in faith (that is, you're able to say, "God, I believe you are real and I want to know you on a personal basis), God will make Godself known to you.

So, what about you? Have you responded to God in faith?

If so, then I commend you and I encourage you to put God first, spend time with God every single day, and discover what God wants you to do with your life. If not, then I encourage you to do so right now. If you've never had a personal experience with God, then silently and sincerely pray this prayer:



Lord, I am convinced you are real and that you will respond favorably to me. I admit I am a sinner and I need to be saved. I believe that Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead in order to pay for my sins and purchase for me a home in heaven. And I call to you in faith and ask you to save me.
